1. Application of Tariff

Issued: June 24, 1996

- 1.1 This tariff contains regulations, rates and charges applicable to the provision of Carrier Common Line, End User Access, Switched Access, Special Access, Public Packet Data Network, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service(s). These services are provided to customers by the Issuing Carriers of this tariff, hereinafter the Telephone Company. This tariff also contains Access Ordering regulations and charges that are applicable when these services are ordered or modified by the customer.
- 1.2 The provision of such services by the Telephone Company as set forth in this tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the customer for the furnishing of any service.
- 1.3 The regulations and rates contained in Section 3., Carrier Common Line Access Service and Section 6., Switched Access, are not applicable to end users subscribing to FX services until such time as the application of Switched Access charges to FX end users is authorized by the Illinois Commerce Commission. FX end users will continue to be billed to appropriate individual line rates for the open end of FX service.
- The regulations and rates contained in Section 3., Carrier Common Line Access Service and Section 7., Special Access Services are not applicable to customers subscribing to WATS and/or WATS-type services whereby the traffic consist of a mix of InterMSA and IntraMSA usage and where the IntraMSA usage is switched and carried by the Local Exchange Company until such time as the application of those charges is authorized by the Illinois Commerce Commission.
